Special Conditions

- 1. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Waikare, any temporarily moored floating stand or any stand, hide or maimai which is permanently fixed to the lake bed except within 180 metres of the outer margin of the lake, or the shoreline of Motu Nuia Island (Grape Island).
- 2. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Ngaroto any fixed stand, pontoon, hide or maimai except within 85 metres of the margin of the lake.
- 3. No person shall use or cause to be used for the hunting or killing of game on Lake Rotokauri any fixed stand, pontoon, hide or maimai on any open water of the lake.
- 4. It shall be an offence for any person to wilfully leave on the hunting ground any game bird(s) shot or parts of any game bird(s)
- 5. It shall be an offence for any person to herd or drive black swan(s) for the purpose of hunting or killing them.
- 6. It shall be an offence to shoot game from any unmoored boat on the Waikato River north of the boat ramp at the confluence of the Mangawara Stream and the Waikato River at Taupiri on any of the first three days or the second weekend of the open season.

Declaring an Open Season for Game in the Firth of Thames for the 1987 Game Season

An open season for game is declared in that area of the Firth of Thames hereinafter named the Firth of Thames Open Game Area and being that area that is enclosed between the boundary of the Auckland Acclimatisation District and a line connecting the points on that boundary by passing through Orere Point on the west side of the Firth and the southern headland of Fantail Bay on the Coromandel Peninsula, subject to the conditions specified hereto and in the First Schedule and in the First Schedule.

Conditions

- 1. Game may only be hunted or killed in the Firth of Thames Open Game Area in compliance with conditions specified for the Auckland Acclimatisation District 1987 open season for game.
- 2. Any licence authorising the holder to hunt or kill game within the Auckland Acclimatisation District for the 1987 open season for game shall similarly authorise the holder to hunt or kill game in the Firth of Thames Open Game Area.
