2. Fees for documents—The fees which the New Zealand Railways Corporation may charge for the preparation of the documents specified in section 118 of the New Zealand Railways Corporation Act 1981 shall be those prescribed in the Schedule to this notice.

3. All fees quoted are inclusive of the Goods and Services Tax.

4. The New Zealand Railways Corporation (Fees for Documents) Notice 1982 is hereby revoked.
