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Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 8) 1987

NOTICE

1. Short title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 8) 1987.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 13th day of April 1987.

2. Exchange rates—Where under any provisions of the Customs Act 1966 any amount which is required to be taken into account for the purpose of assessing duty or any other purpose is not an amount in New Zealand currency, the amount to be so taken into account shall be the equivalent in New Zealand currency of that amount ascertained in accordance with the rate of exchange set out in the Schedule to this notice.

3. Revocation—The Customs Exchange Rates Notice (No. 7) 1987, published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, No. 35, dated 19 March 1987 on page 1252 is hereby revoked.

DECISION

THESE publications were part of a commercial shipment imported by airmail through the Port of Auckland in August 1986. The publications were seized by the Collector of Customs at Auckland and referred to the Tribunal for classification.

As the tribunal understands the matter, the publishers and distributors very responsibly imported these publications in this way in order that they should be referred to the tribunal for classification.

In his submission on behalf of the Comptroller of Customs, Mr Eggleton advised the tribunal that, in his opinion, the books were presented in a serious and respectable fashion and were clearly of an informative nature and were not designed to exploit prurient
