interest. Evidence was called by Mr Ellis from Doctor Graham Paul Davidson, a clinical psychologist and university lecturer. That evidence was of considerable help to the tribunal. Mr Ellis informed the tribunal that parts 1 to 20, which the tribunal had to consider, were part of a 96 part series which was to go on sale on a weekly basis.

The tribunal finds that the publication is indeed a serious publication, in many ways similar to the publication *Man and Woman*, which received a classification of indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 16 years except when they are being advised by parents or professional advisers. The tribunal finds that the 16 year age restriction should apply to these publications parts 1 to 20 and accordingly classifies each of the 20 parts as indecent in the hands of persons under the age of 16 years.
