HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to section 3 (3) of the Trustee Banks Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Trustee Banks (Change of Name) Order 1987.
(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
2. **Approval of changes in name**—Each trustee bank named in the first column of the Schedule to this order is hereby given approval to change its name to the name that is set out in the second column of that Schedule opposite its existing name.
