Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 9) 1987

3. The exemptions from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations, in respect of the classes of goods set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, included in the exemption notices shown in the

Second Schedule, are hereby withdrawn.
