

Takapau S.D.; thence northerly to and along that boundary to the middle of the Mahuraiti Stream; thence north-westerly along the middle of said stream to a point in line with the northern boundary of Rakautatahi 4B Block; thence easterly to and along that boundary to and along the northern boundaries of Rakautatahi 1M2, 1M1, 1D1 (crossing the intervening Public Road) and A2 Blocks and the western boundary (crossing the intervening Public Road) of Rakautatahi 1C2D Block to the southern side of Makaretu River Road; thence westerly along said roadside to a point in line with the western boundary of Rakautatahi A1 Block; thence northerly, across Makaretu River Road; to and along that boundary and that boundary produced to the middle of the Makaretu River; thence westerly along the middle of said river to a point in line with the western boundary of part Lot 3, D.P. 1065; thence northerly to and along that boundary and that boundary produced, across a Public Road, to the south-eastern corner of Lot 1 of 154; thence along the southern boundary of said Lot 1 of 154 and the south-eastern boundary (crossing an intervening Public Road) of Lot 2 of 154 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of the Makaretu River; thence westerly along the middle of said river to its source and due west to the summit of the Ruahine Ranges; thence northerly along the said summit to its intersection with a right line between Trig Station 32 (Aorangi), Block XI, Pukeokahu S.D. and the confluence of the Makaroro River and Dutch Creek in Block IX, Wakarara S.D.; thence south-easterly along the said right line to the confluence of the Makaroro River and Dutch Creek and easterly along another right line to the northernmost point of Section 1, Block XI, Wakarara S.D.; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of said Section 1 to the middle of the Mangamauku Stream and south-easterly along the middle of said stream to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Lot 5, Deeds Plan 156; thence north-easterly to and along that boundary to and along the north-western boundaries of D.P. 9343, part Lot 4, Deeds Plan 156, Block 5, Gwavas Crown Grant District, again part Lot 4, Deeds Plan 156 and Lot 3, Deeds Plan 156 to and along the south-western and north-western boundaries of part Lot 2, Deeds Plan 156 and the north-western boundary of part Lot 1, Deeds Plan 156 to the left bank of the Poporangi Stream; thence north-easterly along said bank to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of D.P. 4106; thence north-easterly to and along that boundary to and along the north-eastern boundary of part Lot 1, Deeds Plan 156 to the western side of Kereru Road; thence along a right line across said road to the north-western corner of Lot 1, D.P. 7063; thence along the north-eastern and eastern boundaries of said Lot 1, the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of part Lot 1, Deeds Plan 467 and the north-eastern boundary of part Lot 2, Deeds Plan 465 to the easternmost corner of said part Lot 2; thence southerly along a right line to the north-eastern corner of part Lot 3, D.P. 6848; thence along the eastern boundary of said part Lot 3, the left bank of the Mangamate Stream and the northern boundary of part Lot 1, D.P. 9399 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of No. 50 State Highway; thence southerly along the middle of said highway to a point in line with the northern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 8552; thence easterly to and along that boundary and that boundary produced to the middle of the Mangaonuku Stream; thence south-easterly along the middle of said stream to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Section 7, Block X, Maraekakaho S.D.; thence south-easterly along a right line, crossing Sections 7, 2 and 5, Block X aforesaid, to the north-western corner of Section 1, Block XIV, Maraekakaho S.D.; thence along the north-eastern boundary of the said Section 1 to the western side of Te Onepu Road; thence along a right line across said road to the northernmost corner of Section 1, Block XV, Maraekakaho S.D.; thence along the north-eastern boundaries of said Section 1 and part Lot 29, D.P. 4416, the north-western and north-eastern boundaries of Pouputahi D2 Block, the north-eastern boundary of Pouputahi C Block, the north-western and north-eastern boundaries of Pouputahi 4D Block and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of No. 2 State Highway; thence northerly along the middle of said highway to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Papaaruhe 4A and 4C1 Blocks; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary to and along the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of Papaaruhe 4A Block and the northern boundaries of Lots 17, 17A and 17B, D.P. 4386 to the western side of the Palmerston North - Gisborne Railway; thence southerly along the western side of said railway to the middle of Boundary Road; thence south-easterly along the middle of said road, Te Aute Trust Road and Aupaki Road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of part Patangata 3B2 Block; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary to and along the north-western boundary of Patangata 3C2B Block and the south-western boundary of Patangata 3D2 Block to the middle of Te Aute Trust Road; thence north-easterly along the middle of said road and southerly along the middle of Middle Road to the middle of Papanui Stream; thence north-easterly generally along the middle of said stream and the Tukituki River to and southerly and north-easterly along the middle of the Hawea Stream to a point in line with the northern boundary of part Section 4, Block III, Oero S.D.; thence easterly to and along that boundary to and along the eastern boundaries of said part Section 4 and Sections 2 of 5, 6 and part 7, Block III, Oero S.D. to the northern side of Waipoapoa Road; thence along a right line across

said road to the north-eastern corner of Section 46, Block VII, Oero S.D.; thence along the eastern boundary of said Section 46, the northern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 3309, Lots 1 and 2, D.P. 3728 and Kairakau 2D1 Block and the western and northern (crossing Te Apiti Road) boundaries of Lot 2, D.P. 3216 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the sea coast, the point of commencement.

The said area of supply being more particularly shown outlined in black on plan NZE 2154 (Sheets 1 to 11) deposited in the office of the Ministry of Energy at Wellington.

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*Cambridge Electric Power Board Electricity Supply Licence 1987*

I, Robert James Tizard, Minister of Energy, acting pursuant to section 20 of the Electricity Act 1968, hereby licence Cambridge Electric Power Board, hereinafter called the Electrical Supply Authority to supply electricity, and to lay, construct, put up, place and use all electric lines and works which may from time to time be required for the distribution and supply of electricity within the area specified in the Schedule hereto.

This licence is issued subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. This licence may be cited as the Cambridge Electric Power Board Electricity Supply Licence 1987.
2. The Electrical Supply Authority shall comply with the provisions of this licence, the Electricity Act 1968 and all enactments made in amendment of or substitution for that Act, any Electrical Codes of Practice made under that Act, the Electrical Supply Regulations 1984, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1976 and all regulations made in amendment of or substitution for any of those regulations.
3. Any notice to be given to the Electrical Supply Authority shall be sufficient if sent by registered post letter to the offices of the Electrical Supply Authority.
4. Any notice to be given on the part of the Minister of Energy shall be sufficient if given in writing by the Minister or by any persons acting under the authority of the Minister.
5. Any notice to be given to the Minister of Energy shall be sufficient if given in writing to or sent by registered post letter addressed to the Secretary of Energy, Ministry of Energy, Wellington.
6. This licence shall not be construed as granting a consent to generate electricity pursuant to section 25 of the Electricity Act 1968.
7. This licence shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1987 and shall continue in force for a period of 21 years from that date unless it is sooner lawfully determined in accordance with clauses 8 or 9 hereof.
8. The Governor-General in Council may pursuant to section 22 of the Electricity Act 1968 cancel this licence if the Electrical Supply Authority is in breach of the provisions contained in clause 2 of these conditions.
9. This licence may be cancelled by the Minister of Energy at the request of or with the consent of the Electrical Supply Authority.
10. At the expiry or cancellation of this licence, the Electrical Supply Authority shall as required by notice in writing by the Minister of Energy remove all buildings, poles and other erections and all transmission lines, plant and other machinery and other removable equipment authorised by the licence to be erected, installed or provided and if within 12 months after being so required the Electrical Supply Authority fails or neglects to remove the same, then the same shall, without payment of any compensation vest in and become the property of the Crown and it shall be lawful for any person authorised by the Minister of Energy in that behalf, subject to compliance with section 15A of the Electricity Act 1968 to enter upon any land or premises and take possession of and remove the same or any part thereof.
11. Nothing contained in the licence either expressly or by implication shall be deemed to authorise the Electrical Supply Authority to erect, construct or maintain any lines or works except subject to such conditions (not inconsistent with this licence) as may from time to time be lawfully imposed by any local authority within the district of which any such lines or works may be situated.
12. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) of regulation 13 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1984.
13. The Electrical Supply Authority shall, 6 months prior to the expiry of the term of this licence provided in clause 7 herein, make written application to the Minister of Energy for the granting of a new licence.
