Customs Import Prohibition (Chlorofluorocarbons) Order 1988

The Customs Import Prohibition (Chlorofluorocarbons) Order 1988

Since 1 July 1988, to give effect to New Zealand's obligations under the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer, the importation of substances specified in the Customs Import Prohibition (Chlorofluorocarbons) Order have been prohibited except with the consent of the Minister of Trade and Industry and subject to such conditions as he thinks fit. Applicants for consent to import chlorofluorocarbons may be made to the Department of Trade and Industry.

To provide for a transition to the new regime, I hereby give my consent for the prohibited substances specified in the Customs Import Prohibition (Chlorofluorocarbons) Order 1988 to be imported into New Zealand until 28 September 1988, on the condition that information with respect to sales and usage of chlorofluorocarbons is supplied to the Department of Trade and Industry before that date, on the forms provided by the department for that purpose.
