Notice

This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Thames-Coromandel District) Notice No. 1, 1988.

The road specified in the First Schedule is declared to be a closely populated locality for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

The roads specified in the Second Schedule are declared to be

70 kilometres an hour speed limit areas pursuant to regulation 21 (2) of the Traffic Regulations 1976.
