In terms of Regulation 70(b)(iii) of the Customs Regulations 1968, 'Goods Wholly Manufactured in Australia', the following materials have been determined:

Ascorbic acid, British Pharmacopoeia 1980 or United States Pharmacopoeia XX Grade, no particle greater than 180 micron in diameter

Cyanocobalamin, British Pharmacopoeia 1980 Grade, diluted to 0.1% with Mannitol, Hydrolysed Gelatin or Vegetable Gum, no particle greater than 180 micron in diameter

Thiamine Hydrochloride, British Pharmacopoeia 1980 Grade, no particle greater than 180 micron diameter
