Area A: All that area of the Southern Lakes Acclimatisation District, outside the Westland Land District, lying east of the Southern Alps main divide.

Area B: That area of the District within the Westland Land District west of the Southern Alps main divide.

Canada goose may be hunted or killed 24 hours per day during the specified open season.

Area B: 6.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.
