NOTES—(1) (a) In accordance with regulation 69 of the Education (Assessment, Classification and Appointment) Regulations 1976, Section 1 shows a teacher classified as belonging to List B for 1988.

- (b) In addition this list includes the names and qualifications only of teachers who are holding List B classification but who were not employed as full-time assistants in State secondary schools and manual training centres as at 12 February 1988. The names have been compiled in accordance with the procedures outlined in the Education Gazette of 1 March 1988, Vol. 67 No. 4.
- (c) Teachers classified in List B who are not employed in State schools are to notify the appropriate Regional Superintendent of Education, Auckland, Wellington, or Christchurch of any errors.
- (d) Teachers whose names are not included and who consider they are eligible for inclusion in this list are to apply in accordance with instructions given in the Education Gazette of 4 March 1988.
- (2) In the location column the following abbreviations are used: "Coll" for College, "GS" for Grammar School, "HS" for High School, "Sch" for School, "TC" for Technical College, "EB" for Education Board, "Mem Coll" for Memorial College, "(M)" for Itinerant Music Specialist, "MTC" for Manual Training Centre or manual teacher. Also shown in this column are teachers undergoing additional training, e.g., "Education for Handicapped" and the location of those exchange teachers eligible for automatic inclusion.
- (3) Positions of responsibility in area schools are designated by the figures 1, 2, and 3. For secondary schools positions of responsibility are designated 1, 2, 3, and 4. The figure 6 indicates a senior master or mistress and 7 a deputy principal. L indicates a teacher on leave.
- N.B.—(4) Teachers employed in State schools are to notify their employing boards or salary servicing agencies of errors or omissions. Inquiries are to be addressed to the appropriate Regional Superintendent of Education, Auckland, Wellington, or Christchurch.
