This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Levin Borough) Notice No. 1 1989.

The roads specified in the First Schedule are excluded from the limitation as to speed imposed by section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

The roads specified in the Second Schedule are declared to be 70 kilometres an hour speed limit areas pursuant to regulation 21 (2) of the Traffic Regulations 1976.

The roads specified in the Third Schedule are declared to be limited speed zones pursuant to regulation 21 (2) of the Traffic Regulations 1976.

The Traffic (Levin Borough and Horowhenua County) Notice No. 1, 1988, signed on the 15th day of April 1988*, issued pursuant to section 52 of the Transport Act 1962 and regulation 21 (2) of the Traffic Regulations 1976, is revoked.

First Schedule

Situated within Levin Borough:

No. 1 State Highway (Awanui-Bluff): from the southern boundary of Levin Borough to a point 640 metres, measured north-easterly, generally, along the said State Highway from the said boundary.

No. 1 State Highway (Awanui-Bluff): from the northern boundary of Levin Borough to a point 920 metres, measured southerly, generally, along the said State Highway from the said boundary.

No. 57 State Highway (Levin-Palmerston North via Shannon): from the eastern boundary of Levin Borough to a point 480 metres measured north-westerly, generally, along the said State Highway from the said boundary.
