Summary of Bills Introduced

Auckland Harbour Board and Devonport Borough Council (Ngataringa Bay) Empowering Act Repeal

This Bill repeals the Auckland Harbour Board and Devonport Borough Council (Ngataringa Bay) Empowering Act 1970.

Cornwall Park Bylaws Empowering

The intent of this Bill is to empower the Cornwall Park Trust Board to make bylaws in respect of Cornwall Park, Auckland. Cornwall Park Trust Board erroneously considered itself to have such bylaw-making powers pursuant to the Reserves and Domains Act 1953. Bylaws purported to be made under that Act are invalid.

Matamata County Council Empowering

This Bill seeks to empower the Matamata County Council to sell land vested in it as a site for a public hall.

Queenstown-Lakes District Council (Rating Relief) Empowering

This Bill seeks to empower the Queenstown-Lakes District Council to grant relief from rates commitments during the development or redevelopment of certain properties for industrial, commercial, administrative, or tourist purposes.
