NOTICE 1989 - 3

In terms of Regulation 70(b)(iii) of the Customs Regulations 1968, 'Goods Wholly Manufactured in Australia', the following materials have been determined:

- -- Cultured pearls to jewellery standard
- Synthetic or reconstructed precious or semi-precious stones
- Precious stones other than diamonds, sapphires, opals, jade and greenstone
- Cut sapphires
- Cut diamonds, commercial grade and colour, for production of jéwellery
- Cut emeralds and rubies
