- 1. Title and commencement—This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Chatham Islands Rock Lobster Closed Season) Notice and shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1989.
- 2. Interpretation—In this notice, the term:
 - "Rock Lobster" means those fish of which the scientific names are *Jasus edwardsii* (commonly known as the spiny or red rock lobster) and *Jasus verreauxi* (commonly known as the packhorse or green rock lobster).
 - "Chatham Islands rock lobster fishery" means the rock lobster fishery bounded by all that area of New Zealand fisheries waters enclosed by a line commencing at the point of 40° 25′S and 178° W on the outer limits of the exclusive economic zone; then proceeding along the outer limits of the zone to the point 51° 50′S and 174° 25′E; then proceeding in a straight line to the point 50° 50′S and 174° 25′E; then proceeding in a straight line to the point 50° 55′S and 173° 50′E; then proceeding along the outer limits of the zone to the point 48° 15′S and

 $174\,^\circ$ E; then proceding in a straight line to the point of commencement.

3. Closed season for rock lobster determined—There is hereby determined to be a closed season for rock lobster in the Chatham Islands rock lobster fishery commencing on the 1st day of March 1989 and expiring with the 30th day of April 1989, both days inclusive.
