Pursuant to section 3 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Transport and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby redefines the limits of the Harbour of Napier as shown on plan M.D. 16514, deposited in the office of the General Manager (Maritime Transport), Ministry of Transport, Wellington, and as more particularly described in the Schedule below.

The Warrant of 22 September 1902* defining the limits of Napier Harbour is hereby revoked.

Schedule

All that area of tidal waters enclosed by the arc of a circle of radius 3.5 nautical miles based on East Pier light in position 39° 28.77'S, 176° 53.74'E.
