Pursuant to section 175D of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby vests in Port of Tauranga Limited, the land described in the Schedule hereto, which land was authorised for reclamation by Order in Council of 28 November 1988*, such land to be vested for port purposes.

All that area of land comprising 1.1680 hectares, being located in Block VI, Tauranga Survey District as shown on plan M.D. 16532 (S.O. 58241), deposited in the office of the Maritime Transport Division, Ministry of Transport, Wellington.
