## The Futures Contracts (Options for Quoted Securities) Notice 1990

#### Notice

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Futures Contracts (Options for Quoted Securities) Notice
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- **2. Interpretation**—(1) In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires—
  - "The Act" means the Securities Amendment Act 1988:
  - "Quoted Securities" means securities the issuer of which is listed on the Official Lists of the New Zealand Stock Exchange and in respect of which there is a right of quotation.

- (2) Any term or expression which is not defined in this notice, but which is defined in the Act, shall have the meaning given to it by the Act.
- **3.** Application of Part III of Act to certain options for quoted securities—Any option to acquire or dispose of quoted securities which is offered in accordance with by-laws made by the New Zealand Futures & Options Exchange is hereby declared to be an option to which Part III of the Act applies.
