Broadcasting Standards Authority—Decision No. 15 and 16

Pursuant to section 15 (1) of the Broadcasting Act 1989, notice is hereby given that the Broadcasting Standards Authority has made the following decisions on complaints referred to it for investigation and review:

(i) In decision No. 15/90, the authority upheld a complaint by Dr Brian Perry of Auckland that the broadcast by TVNZ Ltd. of an item on the *Holmes* programme breached the responsibility placed on broadcasters to deal justly and fairly with any person taking part in a programme and to show balance, impartiality and fairness in dealing with political matters, current affairs and questions of a controversial nature.

(ii) In decision No. 16/90, the authority upheld a complaint by the Hon. Richard Prebble, M.P. of Auckland that the broadcast by TVNZ Ltd. of an item on the *Holmes* programme breached the responsibility placed on broadcasters, when discussing controversial issues of public importance, to make reasonable efforts or give reasonable opportunities to present significant points of view either in the same programme or in other programmes within the period of current interest.

Koi Containment Area Boundary Notice 1990

This notice may be cited as the Koi Containment Area Boundary Notice 1990.

Pursuant to regulation 67 (c) (a) of the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983 (as inserted by the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 9), the Director-General of Conservation hereby establishes and describes for the purposes of Part VIIIA of the Freshwater Fisheries
