Now, therefore, I, the Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief aforesaid, hereby proclaim and declare that I have this day taken the prescribed oaths before The Right Honourable Sir Thomas Eichelbaum, Chief Justice of New Zealand, and that I have assumed the said Office of Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief in and over New Zealand under and by virtue of Her Majesty's said Commission.
