Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Notice of Extension of time for Preliminary Determination

By notice dated 12 June 1991, the Secretary of Commerce initiated an investigation to determine both the existence and effect of alleged dumping of the goods listed in the Schedule to this notice. Pursuant to section 12 (2) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, I, Philip Burdon, Minister of Commerce, hereby declare that by reason of:

- (a) The variety of goods and the number of persons involved in this investigation;
- (b) The difficulty of obtaining satisfactory evidence in the investigation

the preliminary determination may be made within 90 days of the initiation of the investigation.
