Fisheries Act 1983

Fisheries (Quota Aggregation Limit Exemption) Notice 1991, (No. 5109)

Pursuant to section 28w of the Fisheries Act 1983, the Minister of Fisheries, after consultation with the New Zealand Fishing Industry Board, hereby gives the following notice:

Notice

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Quota Aggregation Limit Exemption) Notice 1991
- (2) This notice shall come into effect on the day after its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Interpretation—In this notice:
- (a) Any reference to Quota Management Area means the appropriate Quota Management Area as defined in the Fisheries (Quota Management Areas, Total Allowable Catches and Catch Histories) Notice 1986*; and
- (b) Species are specified by way of fishstock codes, being Fishstock Codes defined in the Second Schedule of the Fisheries (Reporting) Regulations 1990†.
- 3. Exemption to quota aggregation limit—(1) As from the date that this notice comes into effect, the consortium of Moana Pacific Fisheries Limited, Aotearoa Fisheries Limited and the Maori Fisheries Commission are permitted to hold

quota and interest in quota in excess of the 20 percent aggregation limit for quota management areas 1 and 2 as provided in section 28w of the Fisheries Act 1983.

(2) The consortium may hold quota and interests in quota for the following species and quota management areas and up to the percentage limits as specified in the table below:
