Electricity Act 1968

The Power Company Electricity Supply Licence 1992

I, John Luxton, Minister of Energy, acting pursuant to section 20 of the Electricity Act 1968, hereby issue to The Power Company Limited (formerly known as Southland Electric Power Supply), hereinafter called "the licensee", a licence to supply electricity to the public:

(a) Commencing on the 1st day of July 1992 and terminating on the 30th day of June 2012, unless it is sooner lawfully determined; and

(b) Within the area specified in the Schedule hereto upon the following conditions:

Conditions

1. This licence may be cited as The Power Company Electricity Supply Licence 1992.
2. Any notice to be given to the licensee shall be sufficient if sent or delivered by (a) post; or (b) telefacsimile; or (c) hand; to the registered office of the licensee. Any such notice, if sent by post, will be deemed to have been received by the licensee on the 3rd day after the date of posting.
3. Any notice to be given by the Minister of Energy to the licensee shall be given in writing and signed by the Minister or by any person acting under the authority of the Minister.
4. Any notice to be given by the Minister of Energy by the licensee shall be sufficient if given in writing and delivered to

the Secretary of Commerce, Ministry of Commerce, Wellington.

5. At the expiry or cancellation of this licence the licensee, at the direction of the Minister of Energy given by notice in writing, shall remove all things which, by virtue of the issuing of the licence, were erected, installed or provided. The Minister may exclude from such removal particular things or types of things listed in such a notice. Should the licensee fail to remove such things within 12 months after the giving of such a notice, then those things not so removed, without payment of any compensation by the Crown to the licensee, shall vest in and become the property of the Crown and it shall be lawful for any person authorised by the said Minister in that behalf to enter upon the land or premises and take possession of and remove such things.

Schedule

Area of Supply

All that area in the Otago, Westland and Southland Land Districts bounded by a line commencing at a point on the sea coast in the middle of the mouth of Longbeach Creek, Block XIII, Tautuku S.D. and proceeding generally north-westerly along the middle of that creek to the western boundary of Block XII, Tautuku S.D.; thence northerly along that boundary and the western boundary of Block V, Tautuku S.D. to a point due east of Trig Station V (Black Horn), Block XIV, Waikawa S.D.; thence due west to that Trig Station and due north to the southern boundary of Block XI, Rimu S.D.; thence along the southern and western boundaries of that Block XI to and westerly and north-westerly along the northern side of the road that forms the northern boundary of Sections 5, 3 and 2, Block XIV, Mokoreta S.D. to a point due south of Trig Station
